WHEREAS, the Judicial Conference of the United States has delegated to the Circuit and District Courts authority to establish a Discretionary and Administrative Library Fund from the proceeds of attorney admission fees beyond the portion required by law to be remitted to the United States Treasury;

And it appears that a Discretionary and Administrative Library Fund was established pursuant to a Resolution of the Court and Administrative Order No. 87-003 on May 13, 1987 and subsequently amended by Administrative Orders dated December 16, 1996; July 14, 2002; and May 10, 2004.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the fee for admission to practice as an attorney before this Court is hereby increased from \$175 to \$200 effective June 1, 2010, and that upon collection of this fee the Clerk shall apportion it as follows:

\$150.00 to the Treasury of the United States; and

\$25.00 to the Discretionary, Administrative and Library Fund of the Court to be designated for reimbursement of costs to attorneys consistent with the policies set forth in the *Pro Bono* Plan for the Western District of Michigan; and

\$ 25.00 to the Discretionary, Administrative and Library Fund of the Court for other purposes consistent with the policies and procedures approved by the Judicial Conference of the United States.
