In Re: THE REASSIGNMENT OF CERTAIN COGNATE CASES PURSUANT TO LOCAL CIVIL RULE 3.3.2(c)

Administrative Order No. <u>17-CA-007</u>

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of Magistrate Judge Ray Kent, certain cases filed by pro se Plaintiff Jody K. Mosley have been determined to be cognate cases which should be assigned to one judge; and

WHEREAS, all assigned Article III Judges having consented, and Case No. 1:17-CV-07, *Mosley v. Becka Management, et al.,* is the earliest numbered case and assigned to the Honorable Gordon J. Quist. The Court being mindful of the need for the exercise of judicial economy,

IT IS ORDERED that the following cognate cases shall be reassigned to the Honorable Gordon J. Quist, pursuant to approved procedure for reassignment of cognate cases and with another case being reassigned in its stead to the judge losing the case.

1. Case No. 1:17-CV-09 (JTN): Mosley v. Duegan.;

2. Case No. 1:17-CV-10 (PLM): Mosley v. Forest Community Center, et al.;

3. Case No. 1:17-CV-11 (RJJ): Mosley v. Gracia; and

4. Case No. 1:17-CV-13 (RJJ): Mosley v. All 54A Workers at Small Claims Office.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that future cases filed by Plaintiff Jody K. Mosley which fall within the cognate case status of these matters shall be assigned directly to Judge Quist, with an adjustment in future case assignments to compensate for the increased workload.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Magistrate Judge Ray Kent shall be the magistrate judge assigned for all the cases rather than a random assignment.

A copy of this Administrative Order shall be filed in each case referenced herein.
