ORDER

Petitioner seeks reinstatement of the privilege of practicing law in this Court. This Court

suspended the privilege by order dated June 15, 2018, based on a suspension imposed by the

Michigan State Bar, and on this Court's then existing Local Rules governing attorney discipline.

The Court has since changed its Local Rules. Under current rules, the Petitioner's original

suspension would have presumptively been limited to the same time frame imposed by the original

suspending jurisdiction. In this case, that would have been only 30 days, provided petitioner

satisfied the other terms of the suspension.

Petitioner has submitted papers demonstrating that Michigan has fully reinstated him.

Moreover, the original suspension was for a limited period and principally tied to a single case.

The Court is satisfied under General Local Rule 2.3(b)(v) that reinstatement is appropriate and that

there is no need for a three-judge hearing panel.

Accordingly, Petitioner's request for reinstatement is GRANTED effective upon entry of

this order. The Clerk of Court shall serve this order on Petitioner at his last known address.
