IN THE MATTER OF ADMISSION OF ATTORNEYS TO PRACTICE BEFORE THE COURT Administrative Order No. 20-AD-080

At its March 2020 session, the Judicial Conference of the United States approved an amendment to the District Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule, promulgated under 28 U.S.C. 1914(b), to increase the fee for attorney admission. This prompted our Court to review its local Plan for the Administration of Discretionary and Administrative Library Fund (last updated January 24, 2017), and related matters. Based on that review, and with the unanimous approval of the Judges of this Court,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the fee for admission to practice as an attorney before this Court is hereby increased to \$240 effective December 1, 2020, and that upon collection of this fee the Clerk shall apportion it as follows:

\$188 to the Treasury of the United States, for allocation as directed by the Judicial Conference; and

\$52 to the Discretionary and Administrative Library Fund of the Court, to be divided equally between the Pro Bono fund and the general purpose fund, as provided in the Plan.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the fee for any approved *Pro Hac Vice* admission (which is discouraged under Local General Rule 2.2(a)) remains at \$35.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this supersedes Administrative Order 16-AD-117, and modifies the January 24, 2017, version of the Plan. The Clerk of Court is authorized to promulgate a new version of the Plan incorporating these changes.
